Using LabQuest 2 with an iPad

Switch on LabQuest 2 (it takes a while)

Plug in probe to Channel 1

→ Home page

→Connections

WiFI ON

Name: LabQuest Data sharing: ON

Deselect Allow connected devices to start/stop collection

(Otherwise students could switch off the collection by the LabQuest)

→0K

Network Settings symbol (top right)

Scroll down the networks

→ Create a network

Give it a name, use the number on device (e.g. Labquest 5)

Create

OK

QR Code displays in the box

Switch on iPad

Open settings

Switch Wifi ON

In WiFi

Chose a network

Select LabQuest...

(WiFi should now say LabQuest... next to it)

Open Graphical Analysis

→ Create an experiment

Data sharing

→ Specify source

Click Camera

→ Scan OR Code

(make sure the camera is enabled on the iPad, it should ask you but if not it is in settings).

Click Connect

Connection made with LabQuest...

Back to Labquest

- **→**Home
- **→**LabQuest App

Set Mode/ Frequency of measurement

Press record tab (green arrow)

Graph appears in real time on the iPad

You can add a trend line, curve fit etc.

Edit

- → Waste bin
- → Delete experiment

Terminate network in Network Wifi connection preferences
